Student Orientation

Orientation provides a quality transitional experience and maximizes a student's potential for personal and academic success. Orientation is an enrollment requirement for all new students. Admitted students will be mailed information on orientation sessions. Students who have attended the College in the past and are re-enrolling are required to attend orientation if their last orientation was missed or if they have been off campus for more than 12 months prior to the start of their school term.

Program Deans and Department Managers may require certain faculty members to meet with students for a departmental breakout session during an orientation.

Student Organizations/Student Clubs and Chapters

Student clubs and organizations are overseen by the Student Government Association (SGA). A list of current student organizations can be found on the **Dunwoody website**.

Faculty members are assigned as the contact for student clubs/organizations/chapters that usually align within their instructing area.

Students have the opportunity to start their own club/organization if one doesn't currently exist at the College. Students should be directed to a Leadership and Engagement Coordinator in Student Affairs for direction on how to start the process.
